Conditions We Treat

Our pediatric surgeons provide care for a full range of conditions from the minor to the highly complex, including:

- Appendicitis
- Chest wall deformities, including pectus excavatum and pectus carinatum
- Childhood obesity
- Childhood tumors, including Wilms tumor, neuroblastoma, and teratomas
- Inflammatory bowel disease, including ulcerative colitis and Crohn's disease
- Congenital anomalies, including gastroschisis, omphalocele, tracheoesophageal fistula, anorectal malformations, intestinal atresia, Hirschsprung's disease, cystic lung lesions, congenital diaphragmatic hernia
- Pediatric hernias, including umbilical hernias, inguinal hernias
- Pyloric stenosis
- Pediatric trauma
