Will need MO License to file petition.

Must have passed Step 3

Previous/current visa sponsorship

If on another visa type a change of status will be required from DoS- can delay start

If currently on a H1B – change of employer is needed, does not usually delay start

Hall Render will require uploads of personal documents directly from resident/fellow

From the program the GME office needs highlighted information

You may be asked to help hang the Notice of Intent at locations where a H1B recipient will work- instructions will be sent with Notice.

The original H1B petition(I797) is mailed to the resident/fellow by SSM Immigration Team for the Embassy Interview for visa stamp. The Visa interview process is a consular process, we do not have any influence regarding interview wait times and processing times, both of which can delay start of residency/fellowship.

During the interview, the consular officer will determine if the applicant is eligible for a visa and may take digital fingerprint scans. After the interview, the consular officer will inform the applicant if their visa was approved or denied. If approved, the consular officer will provide information on how and when the applicant will receive their passport and visa. If denied, the consular officer will explain why the applicant is ineligible.

While in training if a resident/fellow on an H1B is required to work at a location not listed on the Notice of Intent, please notify the GME office, as an amendment to their H1B petition is needed before work can start at the new location. This is also needed for Moonlighting request.
