

Saint Louis University Lactation Areas/Baby Changing Stations

MAIN CAMPUS

Busch Student Center:

Room 140B. Please check the key out at the information desk to use the room.

Ritter Hall:

1st Floor Women's Restroom, anteroom. No scheduling necessary.

Student Health Center in Marchetti Towers East:

1st Floor. Please schedule by calling the main desk at 314-977-2323.

Simon Recreation Center:

Lower Level Massage Room. Please schedule with the main desk at 314-977-3975.

Wool Center (3545 Lindell):

HR - 1st Floor, Room 120. No scheduling necessary.

ITS - 3rd Floor, Rooms 352, 354, 356, 358 are open day offices available if not in use. No scheduling necessary, but access to 3rd floor may be needed. Please go to HR main desk or contact Katie O'Connell at 314-977-2317 for assistance.

HEALTH SCIENCES CAMPUS

SSM Health Cardinal Glennon (Main Hospital):

- Rm 2255: 2nd Floor across from elevator 1 & 2 near Surgery check-in. Entry Code is 245. There is a sink and microwave. Fridge is located next door in resident lounge (Rm. 2200). Resident lounge is located one floor down from TCU call room and not far from the PICU (just out the door on the 2nd floor). It has a refrigerator dedicated for breastmilk.
- Rm 2611: Single pumping room in the PICU. This room does not require a code or key, but locks from the inside. Sink is available, access to nearest refrigerator is the resident lounge (Rm. 2200). Resident lounge is located one floor down from TCU call room and not far from the PICU (just out the door on the 2nd floor). It has a refrigerator dedicated for breastmilk.
- Rm 1806: There are two pump stations in the room with curtains for privacy in the NICU. No code is needed for access. There is a fridge and sink available.
- Rm 3225: Unofficial pump in the resident TCU call room. To access, use key code 3124. The call room has a sink. Access to a nearest refrigerator is the resident lounge, located one floor down from the TCU call room and not far from the PICU (just out the door on the 2nd floor). It has a refrigerator dedicated for breastmilk.

Caroline Building:

Room C270K. Please schedule with Andy Griesenauer at 314-977-8438.

Doisy Research Center:

Room 301. Please schedule with Sandra Cornell at 314-977-4228.

SLU Medical Campus- West Pavilion:

Room 315: Please note that there are no refrigerators nearby. You will need to use the location where lunch is stored. For access, you will need to work with security to have badge activated for the room.

SSM Saint Louis University Hospital:

Room 650: 6th Floor near elevators D, E & F. Two secure private locations with Medela Lactina Select Breast Pumps for single or dual pumping. You will need to bring your own supplies. Please note that there are no refrigerators nearby. You will need to use the location where lunch is stored.

-For access, you will need to complete an application and submit to HR. Your hospital issued badge will be coded to allow badge scan access. Once you are in the room, you must sign the Utilization Sheet. Please contact Jay Green at 314-577-0678 to set up badge for access.

OTHER PARTICIPATING HOSPITAL SITES**SSM St. Mary's Hospital:**

There is a lactation room at St. Mary's located on the 1st floor just outside the lab doors. It is key pad operated and all residents, staff, etc. have access. Please contact Lori Hartig for the code- they can make available in the resident work room. There is a refrigerator for breastmilk located in the room.

VA St. Louis Health Care System:

John Cochran: There is a lactation room on the 8th floor. Each of the resident call rooms have brand new refrigerators. For access, a resident would submit a request through their supervisor to be issued a key.

Jefferson Barracks: There are several buildings 5152, 5153, Outpatient Building. There is a private space, it is not designated for lactation in one building.

Mercy Hospital:

Coworker Lactation Suite: 2nd floor NICU (2 rooms)- corridor in between Sibling Play Room and Yellow elevators. There are no refrigerators within the space but the unit has coworker's refrigerators for storage and a sink. Each lactation suite provides a private space with a comfortable chair and a hospital grade Ameda breast pump. If you need a place to store breastmilk-stop by the Lactation Services Department (2nd floor Suite G-2198) or call the Mother-Baby Charge Nurse (314-251-6870).

Coworker Lactation Suite: 5th floor Mother Baby Unit- No refrigerators within the space, but the unit has coworker's refrigerators for storage and a sink. Each lactation suite provides a private space with a comfortable chair and a hospital grade Ameda breast pump. If you need a place to store breastmilk-stop by the Lactation Services Department (2nd floor Suite G-2198) or call the Mother-Baby Charge Nurse (314-251-6870).

Coworker Lactation Suite: 6th floor Mother Baby Unit (2 rooms)- No refrigerators within the space, but the unit has coworker's refrigerators for storage and a sink. Each lactation suite provides a private space with a comfortable chair and a hospital grade Ameda breast pump. If you need a place to store

breastmilk-stop by the Lactation Services Department (2nd floor Suite G-2198) or call the Mother-Baby Charge Nurse (314-251-6870).

Coworker Lactation Suite: Main Lobby in seating area across from the gift shop-No refrigerators within the space, but each unit has coworker's refrigerators for storage, but no sink. Each lactation suite provides a private space with a comfortable chair and a hospital grade Ameda breast pump. If you need a place to store breastmilk-stop by the Lactation Services Department (2nd floor Suite G-2198) or call the Mother-Baby Charge Nurse (314-251-6870).

St. Elizabeth's Hospital:

Room A5027: The room is near the Chapel, about halfway between the cafeteria and the rehab gym. There are no refrigerators nearby. A key has been left at the Rehab nurses' station just a few steps down the hall.
